When a Pastor Leaves

When a pastor leaves a congregation, it can be difficult to figure out boundaries. To prevent things becoming muddy, here are some tips to keeping healthy relationships that the ELCA provides:

- Don't reach out to former pastors for professional pastoral care in times of emotional, spiritual, or physical need or invite them to perform or participate in pastoral acts.
- Do not seek the counsel of former pastors (or their family members) on matters relating to the congregation, including its worship life, finance, administration, leadership, or issues.
- Do speak positively of former pastors. As Martin Luther explains in the Small Catechism, the Eighth Commandment compels us to do so: "We are to fear and love God, so that we do not tell lies about our neighbors, betray or slander them, or destroy their reputations. Instead, we are to come to their defense, speak well of them and interpret everything they do in the best possible light."
- Do, in continuing personal relationships, regard former pastors as friends only. Although it is proper to address any ordained minister as "pastor," in light of the new relationship members will remember that the former leader is no longer serving as *their* pastor.
